Occupational Health Service	Description
DRIVERCHECK Fitness for Duty Experts	 Medical Expert Advice Ask our occupational health team questions related to the COVID-19 pandemic (telephone consultation, and email). COVID-19 Screening and Triage Screening and triaging workers for COVID-19 (such as questionnaire, temperature checks) and reporting results back to company (e.g. "Requires 14 day quarantine", "Recommended for COVID-19 Test", "Fit for Work", etc. Medical Staffing Provide companies with staffing solutions for medical practitioner requirements (NPs, RNs, LPNs, and Technicians) to help during the COVID-19 crisis. Onsite daily occupational health services can include COVID-19 screening, temperature checks, first aid treatment, injury management screening. Education and Webinars Provide education and guidance to assist and, enable companies to make decisions more effectively, including decision flow diagrams to assess whether their workers should come to work (<u>https://www.drivercheck.ca/decision-trees</u>). If there is an elevated temperature (>38 degrees Celsius) or questionnaire response of concern, the participant will be denied access to the site
